Core Psychiatry Privileges:

Core privileges in psychiatry include the ability to admit, evaluate, diagnose, treat, and provide consultation to patients of all ages presenting with mental, behavioral, addictive, or emotional disorders (e.g., psychoses, mood disorders, personality disorders, neuro cognitive disorders anxiety disorders, abuse disorders, developmental disabilities, sexual dysfunctions, and adjustment disorders).

Privileges include providing consultation with physicians in other fields regarding mental, behavioral, or emotional disorders; neuro cognitive; pharmacotherapy; psychotherapy; family therapy; behavior

modification; consultation to the courts; and emergency psychiatry, as well as the ordering of diagnostic laboratory tests and prescribing medications. Privileges also include the performance of a history and physical exam. Practitioners may provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in conformance with unit policies. They may also assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services.

Special Non-Core Privileges in Psychiatry:

To be eligible to apply for a special procedure privilege listed below, the applicant must demonstrate successful completion of an approved and recognized course, or acceptable supervised training in residency, fellowship, or other acceptable experience; and provide documentation of competence in performing that procedure consistent with the criteria set forth in the medical staff guidelines governing the exercise of specific privileges.
