## Reflection Paper Submission Requirements (Pass/Fail)

An Emerging Leader will turn in Reflection Papers for 1) monthly topics based on the seminar and LinkedIn Learning courses assigned (5 assignments), and 2) the program Leadership Forum Mentoring Interviews (1 assignment). The 1-page papers will be graded on the following inclusions to pass:

- 1 paragraph on reviewing the content and *why* the content is important– what topic was discussed; what was learned; so what does this have to do with leadership?
- 2 paragraphs on your experience **applying** the content to your environment – now what did you learn from applying with the people around you?

All Reflection Papers should be completed in MS Word using Times New Roman 12 pt. font in the below format and submitted to [LeadershipDev@erlanger.org](mailto:LeadershipDev@erlanger.org) no later than the day before the following class date and saved with the following title format: **lastname\_assignment#\_YYYYMMDD** or **lastname\_mentoringpaper\_YYMMDD**.

**Emerging Leaders are permitted to turn in one reflection paper late** with valid excuse (sick, emergency, etc.). All reflection papers must contain the above criteria to pass. Papers that fail will be returned and expected to be resubmitted with the next assignment. Emerging Leaders must submit **all** papers to be eligible for graduation.



## Group Project Submission Requirements (Pass/Fail)

An Emerging Leader will participate in a group project related to quality improvement. After the Quality Improvement seminar, participants will form groups of 2 – 5 members, then brainstorm and decide on a group project *to do together*. As part of their assignments, they will create a [Project Charter](#) (click to download).

The group project should be implemented and completed **within 6 weeks**, see schedule for due dates.

The group project is concluded with the submission of the Project Presentation. Project Presentations should be created in the official [Erlanger PowerPoint Template](#) (click to download) and should include 5 Slides and last no more than 3 min to present.

The Project Presentation will be graded on the following inclusions to pass:

- Slide 1: Title and Team Members/Emails
- Slide 2: Scope of Project
- Slide 3: Your Process
- Slide 4: Results
- Slide 5: Lessons Learned & Next Steps
